

Visitor information Port of Västerås

General rules

- **Safety equipment when working in the port:** High-visibility clothing, safety helmet and safety shoes.
- **Safety equipment for visitors:** High-visibility clothing and helmet
- **Vehicles** under 3.5t driving in the port area must have flashing warning lights, visible 360°.
- **Smoking prohibited** when loading and unloading ships and inside all buildings
- Make **sure no one else passes through the gates** into the port area.
- **Speed limit** 30 km/h
- **Idle running** max 1 minute
- **Evacuation** will be carried out according to the evacuation plan
- **Work permit:** No work may be started without permission from Mälardalen AB. For certain work, written permission is required. Special permission is required for hot work.

Call 112 to alert SOS

Be prepared for questions about:

- What happened?
- Where help is needed?
- Who are you?
- Where are you calling from?

If possible, alert:

Siren sound alarm in case of ammonia release from Mälarenergi

The signal sounds in 7-second bursts with a 14-second pause in case of gas alarm due to ammonia release.

- 1. Evacuate the port area** by walking perpendicular to the wind direction. The wind direction is checked by looking at the wind cones.
- 2. Vehicle drivers;** enter the vehicle and close windows and doors as well as ventilation. Drive to the assembly point.
- 3. Reassembly** takes place at the assembly point according to the evacuation plan.
